

City of Port Washington Celebration Tree Program Overview

The City of Port Washington is a beautiful and growing community. As our park system grows, we need trees for shade and park character for visitors to enjoy the scenery.

The Port Washington Parks and Recreation Department would like to offer you an opportunity to honor someone special, to remember a loved one, or to recognize a special event or achievement through our Celebration Tree Program.

Trees will be placed in the Port Washington Parks System and your gift will provide a lasting memory and enhance the beauty and variety of our parks.

City of Port Washington Celebration Tree Program Process

1. Select a tree species. We are open to all types of trees, although Forestry personnel will have final approval. Trees are approximately 1 ½” - 2” in diameter and 7’ - 10’ tall. We recommend the following species: London Planetree, Swamp White Oak, Hackberry, Serbian Spruce, White Pine, Dawn Redwood and Ohio Buckeye.
2. Select a location. Most of the city parks have space for additional trees. We will try to honor your wishes, however the Department may offer additional recommendations.
3. Complete the application. Submit application with a \$400 gift payable to the City of Port Washington. The gift amount reflects the tree, delivery, soil preparation, planting, mulch, water, and perpetual care.
4. Plant the tree. Attendance during the planting process is welcome, but not required. Let us know how you would like to be involved. Trees are planted in the spring or fall.
5. By Department policy, markers or plaques are not allowed to be placed at the tree.
